Scope

- legal instruments of language education;
- applied linguistics;
- theory and practice of teaching foreign languages in the field of professional and intercultural communication;
- semantic space of a language and methods of its development;
- contrastive linguistics and methods of teaching foreign languages;
- applied systems and new technologies in TFLs;
- linguistic, cultural, and sociocultural components in the TFLs;
- linguodidactic fundamentals of TFLs.

Forms of participation in the conference

- presentation with a report (up to 10 min);
- participation in panel discussions (up to 3 minutes);
- full papers in the conference proceedings include mainly accomplished research results and have 5 pages at the maximum.

International participants can opt for online participation. The plenary session will be held at the BSPU and broadcasted on Zoom.

Conference languages:

Belarusian, Russian, English, German, French, Italian, Spanish, and Chinese.

Submissions requirements

Submissions should correspond to the problem field of the conference.

We accept up to 5 pages in the Microsoft Word editor (font Times New Roman, 14 pt., at 1 interval); paragraph indent – 10 mm, left margin – 20 mm, top margin – 15 mm, right margin – 10 mm, bottom margin – 25 mm, pages are not numbered.

Submissions must contain:

- name (font size – 14 pt., UPPERCASE letters, center alignment);
- the initials and surname of the author(s), academic degree, title, position, affiliation, e-mail (corresponding author) (font size – 12 pt., centre alignment);
- summary (80-100 words), key words (5-7);
- text of the publication (up to 10 000 printed characters, including spaces between words, punctuation marks, numbers, etc., font size – 14 pt., aligned in width);

- references should be 12pt Times New Roman, justified, and aligned in width.
All references and in-text citations should follow the APA or an author-date system convention.

Please do not use footers, headers or page numbers.

The submitted materials will be checked via automated Anti-Plagiarism system.
